

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BEN FOLDS is widely regarded as one of the major music influencers of our generation. The Emmy-nominated singer-songwriter-composer has created an enormous body of genre-bending music that includes pop albums with Ben Folds Five, multiple solo albums. and numerous collaborative records. His more recent album was released in June 2023. He currently tours as a pop artist, performs with some of the world's greatest symphony orchestras, and serves as the first Artistic Advisor to the National Symphony Orchestra at the Kennedy Center in Washington, D.C. A New York Times best-selling author and podcast host, Folds is working on new compositions for film, TV, and theatre, and frequently quest stars in films and TV shows. He also continually advocates for improving public policies for the arts and arts education as a member of Americans For The Arts and the Arts Action Fund.

AMY CORDILEONE (Director) is a director, choreographer, and designer whose artistic work and research are focused on investigating aesthetic spaces across the globe. As a full-time faculty member at New York University, Cordileone continues to develop innovative content for a variety of school-wide programs, including the NYU Youth Theatre Ensemble, Theatrix, Playlabs, and the Writers' Roundtable. 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
